The parade is ranked the #1 Thanksgiving parade in the nation by AOL. It features beautifully decorated floats, nationally recognized Drum and Bugle Corps, re-enactment units from every period of American history and military marching units. Before the parade reaches us we will be entertained by top quality entertainers during their opening ceremonies.

After the parade, we will stay to enjoy the festivities & live entertainment all along the waterfront! At scenic Brewster Gardens, you can visit a unique, open-air, Living History Museum with costumed re-enactment troops spanning four centuries of American history. A visit to the Wampanoag Pavilion is your opportunity to learn what really happened at that first dinner between the Colonist and the Wampanoag people in 1621, speak with native people and browse in their beautiful heated craft tent.

Admission is included to The New England Food Festival, taking place in a heated tent where you will sample the very best soups, chowders, desserts, party foods, and entrees in the region from over 20 restaurants. Enjoy live musical entertainment as you eat your way around the tent tasting the best of New England! Also located on the waterfront in a separate tent is the Crafters Pavilion where juried vendors present the finest in New England arts and crafts. Don't forget the kids and grandkids because they have a special heated Kid's Tent located next to Plymouth Rock where kids can explore history through hands on crafts and activities.
